

On June 14, 2021 the East Tallahatchie School District's School Board of Education voted to hire experienced Superintendent and life-long educator Mr. Johnny Vick. The Superintendent search was led by the state agency Mississippi School Board Association (MSBA). As a result of the search the MSBA collected a total 13 applicants and the search was narrowed down to 4 final applicants.
