ORDER

This cause comes before the Court on Defendant Deandre Jones's motion [38] and joinders filed by Zipora Hudson [39] and Montreal Hudson [40] seeking a continuance of the trial set April 8, 2024. Counsel states additional time is needed in order to review the extensive discovery and properly prepare for his defense prior to the trial in this matter. Counsel for the Government does not oppose this continuance. The Court finds that the ends of justice will be served by granting subject continuance and that such action outweighs the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial.

It is therefore ORDERED that the above and foregoing trial is hereby continued until Monday, July 22, 2024, and all pre-trial dates are extended accordingly.

It is further ORDERED that the delay from this date until July 22, 2024, shall be excluded from all computations relative to the Speedy Trial Act pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161 (h)(7)(A) as to Jones, Z. Hudson and M. Hudson.
