ORDER

This cause comes before the Court on the Defendant Zipora Hudson's motion [59] seeking a continuance of the trial set October 21, 2024. Counsel for Defendant Zipora Hudson states additional time is needed to review discovery with his client in preparation for plea or trial. Counsel for the Government does not oppose this continuance. The Court finds that the ends of justice will be served by granting subject continuance and that such action outweighs the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial.

It is therefore ORDERED that the above and foregoing trial is hereby continued until Monday, January 13, 2025, and all pre-trial dates are extended accordingly.

It is further ORDERED that the delay from this date until January 13, 2025, shall be excluded from all computations relative to the Speedy Trial Act pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161 (h)(7)(A) as to Zipora Hudson and Montreal Hudson.
